Funding Codes

If your child is in receipt of any funding that is means tested, such as the extended 30 hours. Please be aware that you have to reconfirm your eligibility on the government website every three months to keep your code active.

This is the responsibility of the family, if this is not kept up to date then the setting will not be able to claim the funding. This means that we will have to bill the family instead.

Email reminders are sent from the government website when reconfirmation is needed.

Water Bottles

Please could we kindly request that children only have water in their drink bottles. If your child wants a carton of juice or a fruit shoot with their lunch then this is fine.

Also please could we request that children bring their drink in a sports bottle with a flip up straw or pop up spout. No screw top bottles please, we have had a lot of spillages with children using these bottles.

September Sessions

Children who will still be attending the pre-school in September will have their sessions confirmed by the end of May.

Please make sure that you have returned your session request form by the date stated on the letter.



Medication

If your child requires doctor prescribed medication while they are at the pre-school, this must have the doctor's label on it, it must state your child's name and the dosage that they require. If the medication does not have this then we will not be able to administer.

Please remember if your child is put on antibiotics then they must have had them for 48 hours before they can return to the pre-school.

Independence

At the pre-school we are trying to encourage and support the children with their independence, this is particularly important for the school leavers. We are regularly practicing taking off our shoes and socks, then putting them back on again. We are supporting the children with learning to put on their own coats and trying to do them up. We are also supporting the children with being fully independent with toileting and wiping their own bottoms. We would really appreciate it, if you could continue to encourage this with your child/ren at home.
